Donation and Recycling Opportunities for April 21

Allen Community Outreach (ACO) would like to have your gently-used indoor and outdoor household furnishings to support their programs—Emergency Services, Rent and Utility Assistance, Information and Referral, and Meals on Wheels.

Allen Noon Lion's Club would appreciate your used eyeglasses, prescription sunglasses, eyeglass frames, eyeglass accessories, and used cell phones.

Allen Animal Shelter would appreciate your gently-used pet products—collars, leashes, toys, toenail clippers, pet bowls, brushes, combs, dog houses, towels, and blankets. Catnip, pet food, shampoo and flea treatment, dip, and treats are also accepted.

Goodwill would appreciate gently-used household goods and clean clothing (washed and bagged, please), children's and adult's accessories and toys.

The Shoe Bank would like to have your gently-used adult athletic shoes and children's shoes of all types to donate to charities worldwide.

Cyclone Aluminum and Steel would like to have your old computers, computer components, copiers, fax machines, telephones, answering machines, printers, ink cartridges, lawn mowers, small electric kitchen appliances (toasters, microwaves, toaster ovens, mixers, etc.), and grills to be recycled.

Community Waste Disposal (CWD) will accept grass clippings, branches, yard waste, and unpainted, unstained fence panels and lumber to be composted; cardboard to be recycled; and white metal (household appliances) without Freon. Appliances will be sold for metal recycling to benefit Allen Community Outreach.
